Our food pantry offers nonperishbable and perishable food to individuals and families in need

OUTCOMES

• Distributed 84,680 pounds of food valued at \$162,656.

Emergency Utility Assistance

Helps keep vital services on when unexpected difficulties result in an upcoming service disconnection or to resume disconnected utilities.

- Electricity: \$25,174 provided to 87 families with 345 people.
- Water: \$4,058 provided to 20 families with a total of 93 people.
- Gas: \$400 provided to 1 family with 9 people.

Gift Cards

Available monthly to contribute toward other expenses.

• \$12,970 in gift cards provided to 161 families.

Thanksgiving Food Drive	H-E-B bags filled with canned and boxed food items to help prepare a Thanksgiving meal, and a \$20 H-E-B gift card to purchase a turkey or ham.	 \$10,835 in Thanksgiving food for 72 families with 315 people.
Christmas Gift Card Drive	\$25+ gift cards to neighbors in need to help with an additional budget for Christmas gifts for their family members.	• \$11,488 in gift cards distributed to 49 families with 205 people.
"Project Cool" Box Fans	Free box fans to qualifying senior citizens and disabled individuals as a low-cost, low-energy means to stay cool in the hot summer months.	• 54 families with 153 people.
